

Basket Raffle and Bake Sale

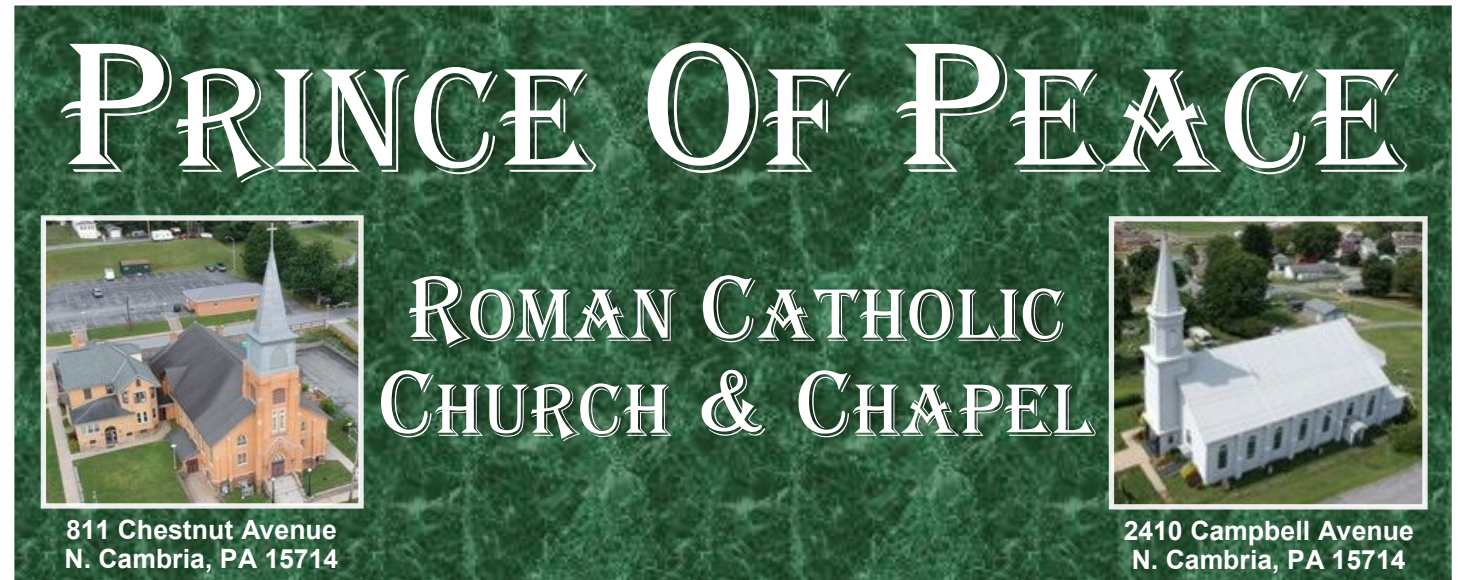
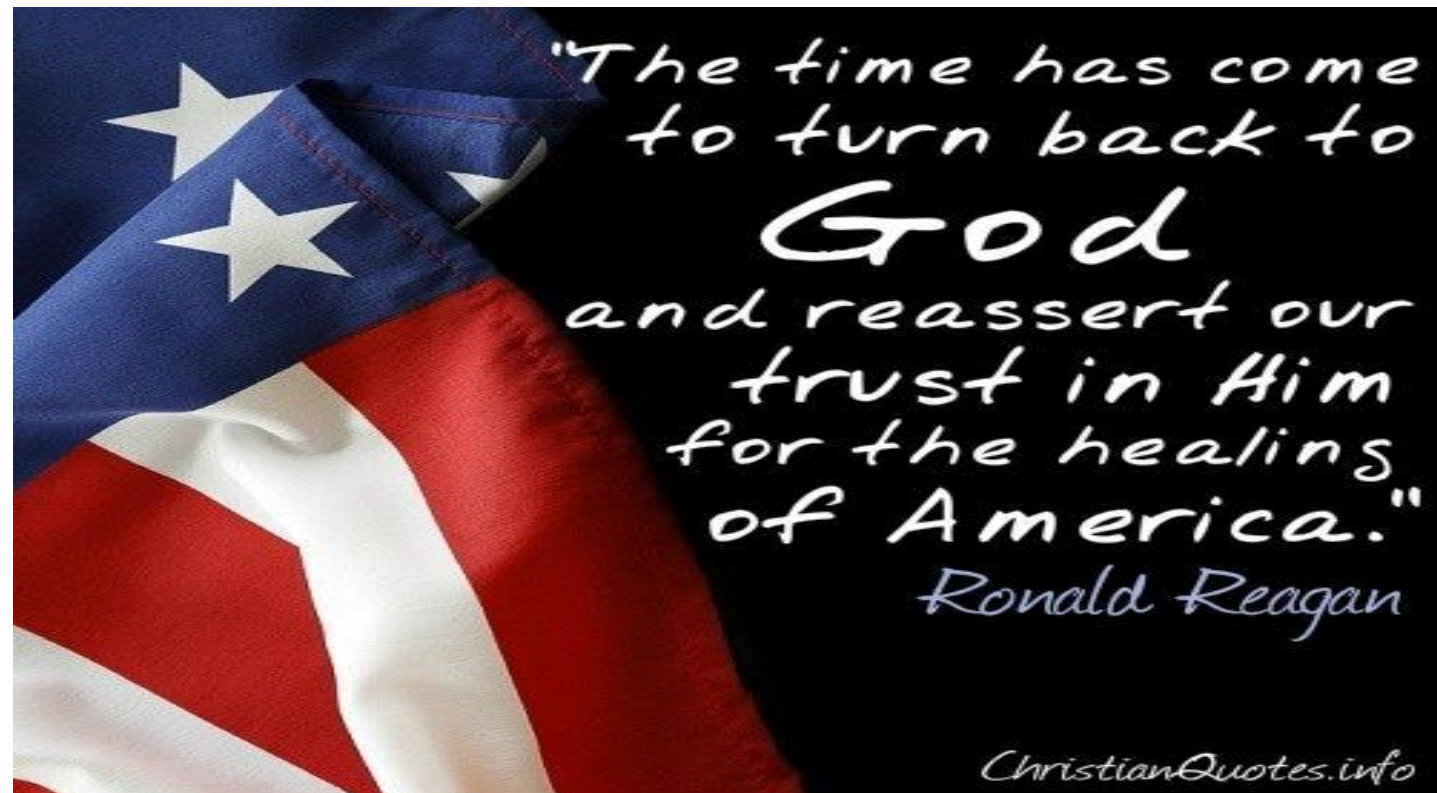
The net profit from the Basket Raffle and Bake Sale was \$3,588.00. These funds will be added to the Furnace appeal.

Special thanks to Erin and Virginia for coordinating, planning and overseeing the event. They would like to acknowledge and thank the following people for their assistance and making the event a success.

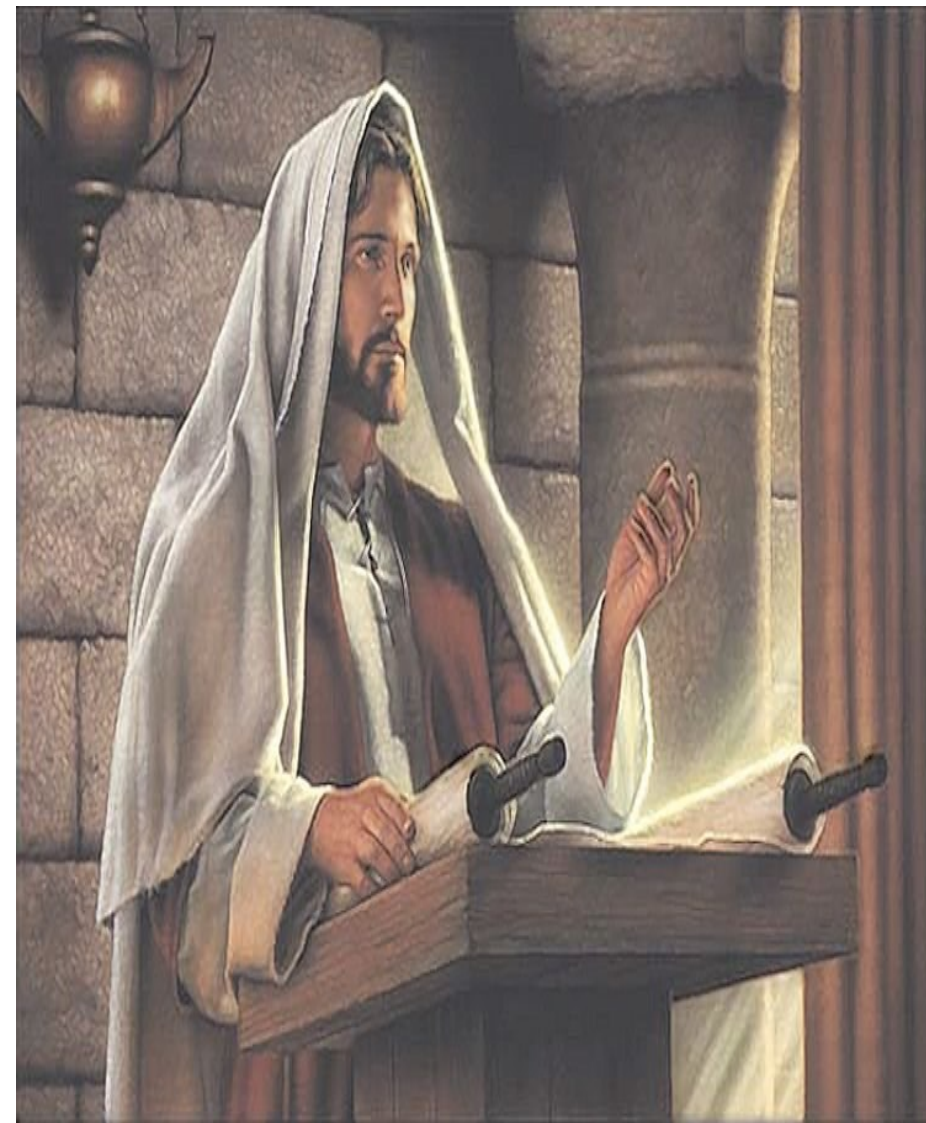

SUNDAY REFLECTION
