




# **Cemetery Policy - Decorations**

- In the interest of the safety of employees and visitors, no glass or ceramic objects are permitted in the Cemetery.
- No decorative stone is permitted. Such <u>objects will be removed by cemetery personnel.</u>
- Fall/Spring cleanup days will be fixed as a weekend in October/April respectively. All decorations must be removed prior to the first day of October/April. Decorating may resume the first day of November/May.
- Permanent Decorations: Statues, flower pots, and plastic vigil lights are permitted only if they are part of the stone.
- Flush flowerpots are permitted next to the stone only with permission of the Management.
- No fences, corner posts, or other border arrangements are permitted.
- Anything that violates these policies will be removed without prior notification.
- No raised mounds are permitted on cemetery lots.
- Graves must be level with the contour of the cemetery ground.
- Up to three arrangements of flowers are permitted on the grave at the time of burial.

#### RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION

Just a reminder that registration for Religious Education for the 24-25 Academic Year will begin on August 1st. The last day to register will be August 30th. Forms will be available in the back of the Church and Chapel and may be picked up after Mass. Forms will not be mailed or on the website. Any registration received after this date will incur an increased registration fee. The parish does NOT set the registration fees. We receive a bulk registration rate, and any individual registration (after the deadline) is at a higher individual registration rate. The parish does NOT assess a late fee. Please get your registrations completed and in on time.

As has been the case for the previous year, classes will be twice a month beginning on October 7th. As in the past, parents are asked to attend the first class with their children. An information packet will be provided at that time which will include a tentative schedule for the year. Please note changes to the schedule may be necessary and we ask for your understanding and cooperation.

Please remember that part of your promise and obligation as parents is bringing up your children in the faith. That entails more than just sending them to religious education. It means bringing them to Mass each Sunday. For those who have children in sacramental years (First Holy Communion and Confirmation) your children cannot receive a sacrament while they are not in a state of grace (being in a state of mortal sin occurs when each time we miss Mass). Please do not break the covenant you made with God twice (once at your wedding and again at their baptism) and bring your children to Mass.
